The Wissler Penthouse is named after Mr. Clarence Wissler (1887-1954), well-traveled magician and escape artist entertainer, returned to his hometown Bellefontaine in the early 1920s and pursued his passion for aviation. His well-respected mercantile family owned and operated Wissler Dry Goods, located on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Metropolitan Building and Clarence built three planes on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, where Lofts110 is now located.
